Biblia Chora winemakers Evangelos Gerovassiliou and Vassilis Tsaktsarlis are two of the modern Greek wine industry's most pivotal characters. Each in his own way was a leader in the country's quality wine revolution.

The location for the Biblia Chora winery was carefully chosen. Kavala's Pangeon mountain is part of an ocean-influenced microclimate in which elevation and weather combine to create a growing season up to two weeks longer than surrounding regions. South-facing vineyards on mountain slopes create the best of both worlds: ripe fruit and high acidity.

Sauvignon blanc/Assyrtiko 2003

Cepage: 50% Sauvignon bLanc, 50% Assyrtiko

Viticulture: Vines grown on south-facing mountain slopes at 350 meters at a distance of 6 kilometers from the ocean. Mean yield of less than 50 hl/ha. Continental climate with cooling downdrafts and ocean winds.

Vinification: Cold temperature prefermentaion (skin contact) followed by classic white fermentation under temperature control in stainless steel.

Analysis: Alcohol: 12.5 %
pH: 3.26 gr/lt
Total acidity: 6.3 gr/lt
Res. sugar: 1.61 gr/lt
